

Pro-Strategy Betting Melbourne and Sydney

Earlier in the week, we presented a plan to profit from Sydney and Melbourne Pro-Strategy bets. We provided detailed statistics and analysis for the 2023-2024 season.

Since then, we have been able to process **all the Pro Strategy qualifiers going back to January 2021**.

We have compiled a spreadsheet which includes every qualifier from Mel and Syd under the rules provided. That came to 1679 bets.

Clearly identifiable risk areas jumped off the pages. We had to nip this in the bud before we start live to avoid wasting bets on those weaker possibilities. It makes working out the qualifiers more complicated but no need to worry. **We will sort the raceday qualifiers out and list them ready-to-bet, as from tomorrow.**

There will be a list of bets for Melbourne and for Sydney. They will be listed on their **respective raceday Mel/Syd member pages online as well as the raceday email.**

The Pro Strategy qualifiers for both Mel and Syd will also be listed on the **Platinum raceday messages.**

Spreadsheet users can immediately analyse the results back to 2021.

You will be love all the extra fields included which will help that analysis no end. (Track, Dist, Type, Going, Rail, \$PM, Pace, AM Odds, Trainer, Jockey, Barrier, Weight, Weight To carry, Form Rating, Scenario Rating, Rated Order, Elite Odds etc.).

It is so easy to filter say all bets at Caulfield, 1400m, rail >5 and get an immediate answer with all qualifying bets in front of you with recalculated summaries.

There's even a column which **records two-bet races** so you can easily filter. (By the way, two-bet races are doing at least as well profit-wise as one-bet races. The 2nd rated qualifiers and third rated qualifiers are neck and neck in regards to % profit as well). More on that next week.

We've pretty much got it how we want it but a bet scale may be built in next week.

It's Friday, so there is no time to produce pdfs, stats and other analysis (or attend to queries). All the answers are in the spreadsheet but we will get you right up to date early next week.

Betting

2023 and 2024 have clearly been the best years for these second and third Elite rated Pro-Strategy bets. But that coincides with a tougher period for the main (mostly top-rated) plans. It is important to keep your main win strategy going whether that be E4 or Nat-Best or both.

Allocate a bank for the Pro-Strategy that is quite separate from the other bank/s. Do not cross-reference between the plans.

The results are great overall and we would recommend a bank of similar size to the current main bank/s that you are running (E4/Nat-Best.)

You will have a portfolio of three Blue-Chips - each with exceptional long-term performance but each working at its own pace. This mix will certainly even out the ride.

We would not recommend exceeding 1.0% of your new bank for these Pro-Strategy qualifiers but keep in mind there may be a sliding betting scale announced next week.
